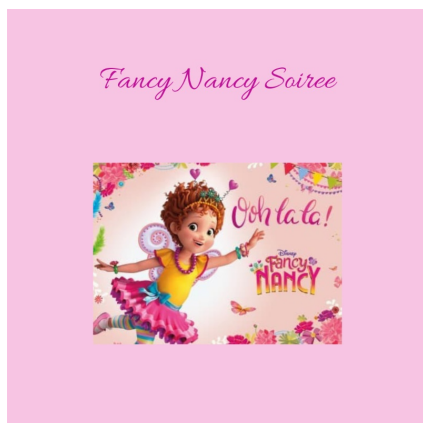


Fairy Tales Grades SK-3
