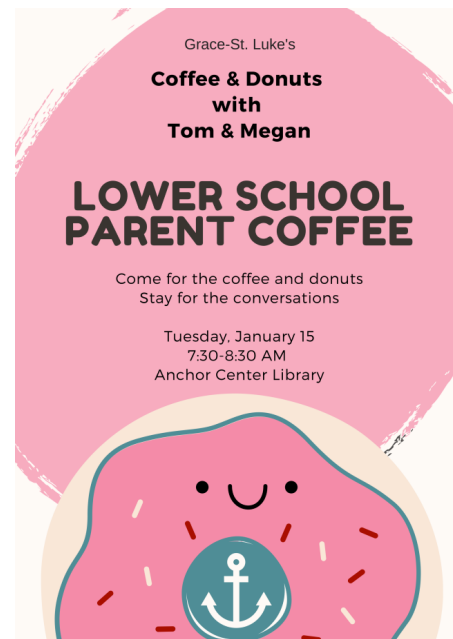

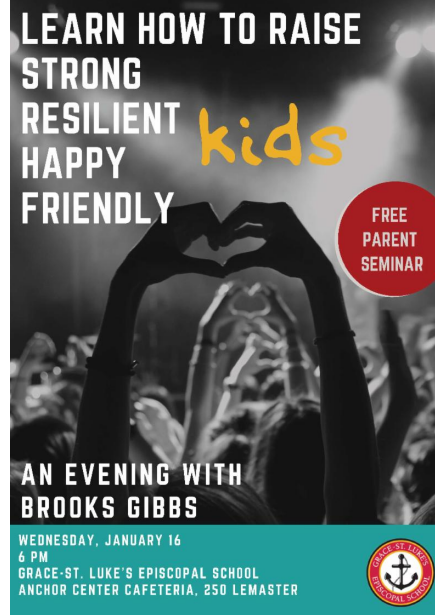

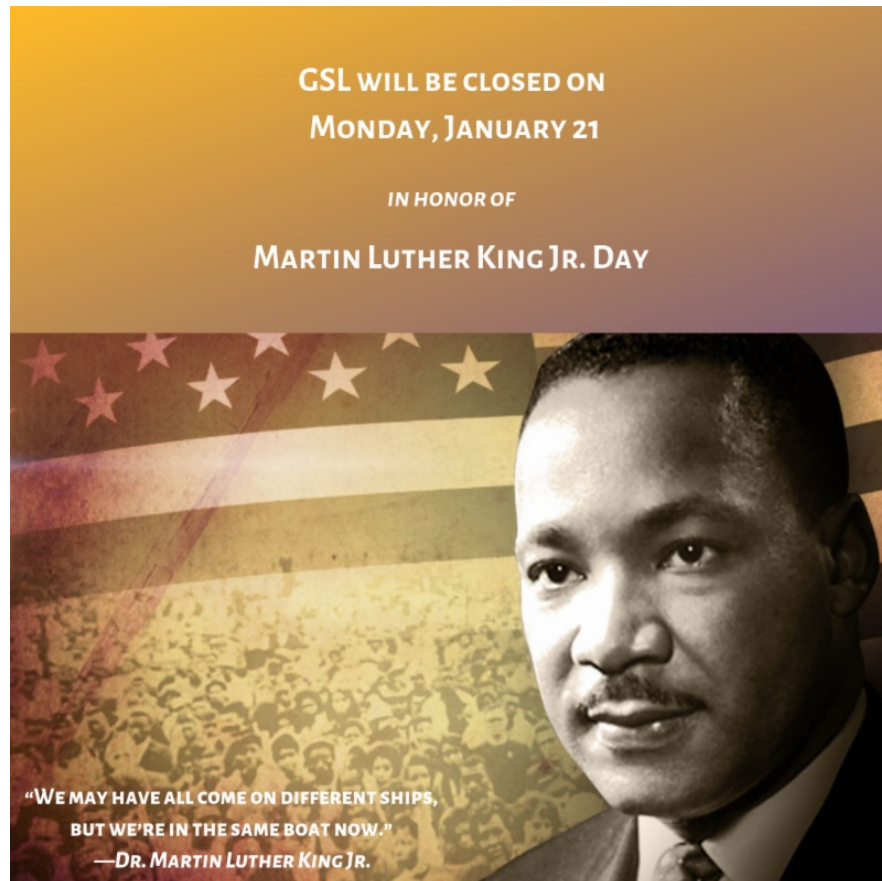
Slime Time Grades: SK-4th

Can't make it on January 31? No problem! Pre-order a quart (or more) of frozen sauce with our carryout service.

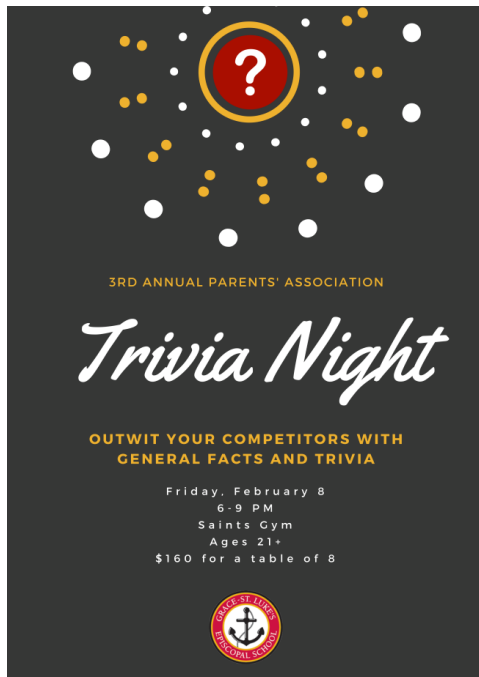
