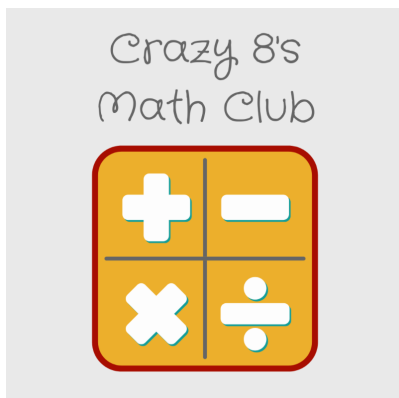

**Here are some tips for the teams:**

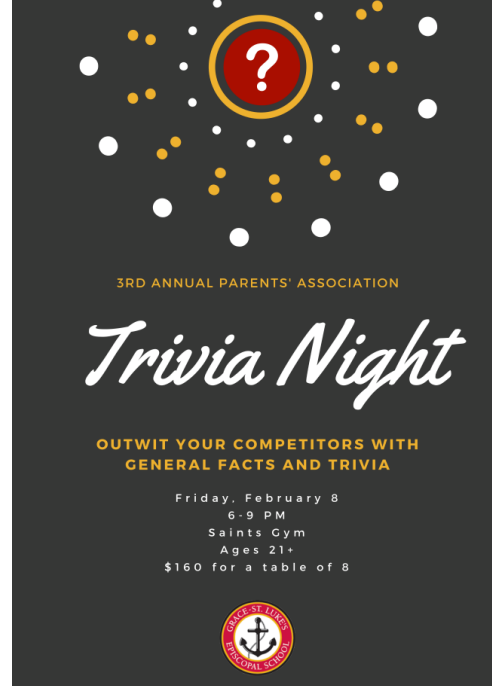
- Bring appetizers/dinner/gourmet feast/snacks/pizza/sushi, and/or beverage(s) of choice—food and drinks will not be provided.
