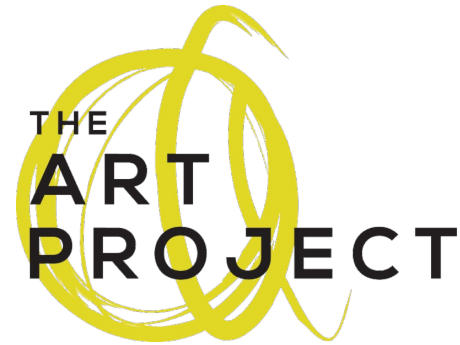
Hospitality Center, where you can get a snack or grab a cold drink, returns this year to the corner of Peabody and Belvedere.
